Breast Cancer: What You Need to Know

In 1952, at the age of 57 our Soror, Hattie McDaniel, lost her battle to breast cancer. She has been one of many African American Women that have been diagnosed and/or lost their life to this horrible disease. As a tribute to her and the importance of early detection in the African American community, the ladies of Sigma Gamma Rho dedicate a specific initiative to bring awareness to the community. Our Hattie McDaniel Breast Cancer Awareness Initiative strives to support women of color by bringing knowledge and resources to the community. Breast cancer is one of the deadliest forms of cancers.



There are approximately 40.000 breast cancer deaths and 250.000 new cases diagnosed each year. Though African American women and their Caucasian counterparts are diagnosed with similar numbers, their mortality rate is significantly higher. African American women have a mortality rate of 40% higher than that of women of any other ethnicity. We must consider why the mortality rate is higher. We must be aware of our access to medical insurance, quality care, and reconsider our perception of the medical field as a whole. Though many are skeptical, this disease effects so many in our community. This hesitation prevents many from seeking early treatment.

> The best thing we can do is educate ourselves, spread knowledge and teach prevention techniques. We must be aware of chemicals in cosmetic products that are harmful and may increase risk. By utilizing and enhancing programs that offer assistance within our communities, we can spread the word so that all have access to early detection and continued care. We must complete regular self-checks and get routine manmograms.

> Early detection is key to decreasing the mortality rate. The Breast Cancer Center at Sunrise is an excellent start for resources, treatment and early screenings. The team there has reduced rate mammograms, and nurse navigation systems to provide services and support for women as they deal with such a troublesome journey. Those diagnosed through their center will have access to a team of high quality doctors to help fight this disease.


